1. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Committee Chair Jackman called the meeting to order at 1:03 pm and called for round table introductions.

2. BUSINESS FROM THE LAST MEETING

- Review of the Minutes of the previous meeting
- Updated Guiding Principles
 - Recommendation that the Guiding Principle #13 be revised to state that "The RDCK will
 operate and maintain solid waste facilities to ensure the safety of staff and residents"
 not customers.
- Proposed Goals
 - Discussion regarding the issue of equitable service levels between rural and urban residents. This should be addressed somewhere in the RRP Update and requires a definition of equitability in the context of solid waste services.

3. DIVERSION OPTIONS DISCUSSION

Maura Walker, Maura Walker & Associates made a presentation on diversion options. Refer to Attachment A hereto.

Discussion points as follows:

- Reduction & Reuse
 - RDCK should increase ability to support reduction and reuse activities such as promotion and education and reuse sheds
 - RDCK should support Trash to Treasure event however concerns expressed regarding material left at curb (illegal dumping)
 - RDCK needs to address problem of illegal dumping of trash at social service agencies engaged in reuse.
- Residential Recycling
 - Committee expressed concerns that recycling is becoming very complex due to the number and type of materials accepted by Recycle BC.
 - Education is becoming more essential to reduce contamination
- ICI Recycling
 - In RDKB, some communities provide curbside recycling collection to small businesses (Fruitvale, Rossland)
 - Committee supports the idea of an ICI working group
 - Committee expressed concerns about limited opportunities for rural ICI to recycle however there was no consensus on RDCK approach regarding ICI sector use of recycling depots
 - Current plan is to allow ICI use of RBC depots.
- CRD Waste Diversion
 - o Committee supports the idea of a CRD working group
 - Committee discussed options to recover clean wood, the use of demolition and renovation permits and the need to address hazardous waste assessments and recycling requirements.
 - o A chipper for wildfire mitigation activities may be needed for community use
- Education and Outreach
 - Committee members support more education and outreach activities
