The Childminder works as a member of the Child Minding team providing temporary care of children using the NDCC programs. Duties include providing a high level of service and a fun experience to children in their supervision with consideration of safety for staff & facility users at all times.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Grade 12 or equivalent
- Early Childhood Educator training an asset
- Caregiver certification an asset
- Standard First Aid
- Basic CPR (AED preferred)
- Satisfactory Criminal Background Check

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:
