Lifeguards

The lifeguard is responsible for the supervision & safety of patrons utilizing the pool at the Salmo & District Recreation Department (SDRD), providing public education, training and proactive response to potential situations.

- Current NL, Standard First Aid current within 2 years and current CPR C recertified annually
- Ability to perform physical skill requirements for the NL
- Strong verbal & written communication skills
- Excellent customer service & public relations skills

Swim Instructors

The Swim Instructor is responsible for ensuring the safety of participants while providing instruction for preschool, children & adult programs provided by the SDRD.

- Current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification
- Current Standard First Aid or Aquatic Emergency Care current within two years & current CPR C recertified annually
- Minimum 16 years of age

The Regional District of Central Kootenay (RDCK) is inviting applications for the positions of **Lifeguard, Swim Instructor and Lifeguard Shift Supervisor** at the Salmo outdoor pool.

These are term positions, beginning in late May and ending in early September 2021. The successful candidates will be expected to work a varied schedule which may include day, weekend and /or evening shifts.

Applicants should submit their applications outlining their areas of skill and/or interest. Preference may be given to applicants qualified to hold more than 1 of these positions.

Lifeguard Shift Supervisors

The lifeguard Shift Supervisor is the person designated to be in charge in the absence of the Head Lifeguard, & is responsible for the supervision of staff & the safety of patrons using the facility.

- Current Water Safety Instructor certification, current NL certification, current CPR certification renewed annually, current Standard First Aid or Aquatic Emergency Care current within 2 years.
- Strong communication, negotiating & influencing skills
- Independent decision making, problem solving & analytical skills
- Ability to function well as a part of a team, as well as to effectively lead a team.

Applications submitted in the form of a resume and cover letter will be accepted by email until all positions are filled.
