



Water Conservation Measures - Boil Water Notice Reminder

Issued: **Mar 30 2021 1:56PM PDT** by The Regional District of Central Kootenay

Locations: **RDCK**

Effective immediately, emergency water restrictions implemented due to reduced well productivity will be lowered to Stage 3 Water Conservation Measures in the Woodland Heights Water System. The Boil Water Notice continues to be in place.

Instructions

Water Conservation Measures for **Stage 3** include:

- Watering of lawns is prohibited.
- Watering of gardens, trees and shrubs **ONLY** between the hours of 6 am - 10 am and 8 pm - 10 pm.
- Watering using drip irrigation, a watering can, and or hand held hose is permitted at any time.

Additional Information

Regional District has implemented remedial efforts (well relining) and is continuing to explore options for increasing well productivity. The current well source is operating at half capacity with some improvement of water quality. We appreciate your cooperation in adhering to the Water Conservation Measures and the Boil Water Notice. These Notices will remain in effect until further notice. Stricter Water Conservation Measures may be required if well production declines.
