Effective immediately, Stage 3 Water Conservation Measures in the Woodland Heights Water System have been reduced to Stage 2.

Instructions

The Regional District of Central Kootenay reminds customers that the well source continues to have production concerns and appreciates your cooperation in managing your water consumption.

Water Conservation Measures for **Stage 2** include:

- Watering of lawns, gardens, trees and shrubs is **ONLY** permitted between 6:00 am-10:00 am and 8:00 pm-10:00 pm.
- Watering of gardens, trees and shrubs by watering can or hand-held hose is still permitted anytime.

Additional Information

The Regional District continues to explore options for increasing well production, which may include securing a new well source. Stage 2 Measures will remain in effect until further notice and stricter Water Conservation Measures may be required if well production declines. Please note that under Bylaw 2766, watering is prohibited during extended power outages.
