RE: FAUQUER WATER SYSTEM CAPITAL PROJECT UPDATE

In 2021 the Regional District started replacement of 1.1km of aged asbestos cement water line along Willow Street and Oak Street in Fauquier. This work was not completed in 2021 due to lost work time due to COVID illness, the heat dome, and area wildfire. The work was planned to be completed in 2022. Previous RDCK construction crew staff have moved on to other employment opportunities and at this time, due to the widespread labour shortage we have been unable to hire a new construction crew and are continuing to pursue recruitment. Once a construction crew has been hired work on the remaining sections of main line to be replaced will resume.

In the interim RDCK Operations staff will inspect the site conditions and make any required safety, drainage and housekeeping improvements.
