- Question regarding budget item CAP-1549-100 capital works communication upgrades – upper reservoir and the related cost estimate of \$40,000 for these works. Staff responded that the budgeted capital expense is a conservative estimate at this time and a refined budget amount will be available via the procurement process and disseminated to the CAC.
- CAC requested that during the intake inspection that the contract underwater divers please confirm the separation distance between the intake and an underwater sewer pipe owned by others. Staff will report back to CAC once the dive team has completed work and submitted a report
- CAC inquired about backup power for the system. Manager Divlakovski explained the components of the system that would need to be considered for the supply of backup power and that this would require further review and reporting back.  
-CAC members requested that staff notify the CAC via email when repairs or contracted services exceed budget. Staff will report back to the CAC on an as needed basis on this request.
- CAC members inquired about invasive species removal and the budgeted line item – staff communicated that CKISS is contracted to identify invasive species in the utility ROW and propose and/or undertake treatment to remove or control.
- CAC members inquired about road maintenance responsibilities and CAC members will reach out to YRB on this item.
