## REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL KOOTENAY

### BYLAW NO. 2142

A bylaw to establish a service to provide water for the Balfour Water Service Area.

WHEREAS, a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate a service under the provisions of Part 24 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay has been requested to establish a service for the purpose of providing water services within a portion of Electoral Area "E";

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay has obtained the approval of electors in accordance with Section 801.2 of the *Local Government Act*.

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The Regional District hereby establishes a water service to be known as the "Balfour Water Service Area".
2. The boundary of the service area is a portion of Electoral Area E, as shown outlined on the attached Schedule A.
3. The participant in the service established under Section 1 of this bylaw is Electoral Area "E".
4. The annual cost of providing this service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:
  - a) Property value taxes imposed in accordance with Division 4.3 of the *Local Government Act*
  - b) Parcel taxes imposed in accordance with Division 4.3 of the *Local Government Act*
  - c) Fees and charges imposed under Section 363 of the *Local Government Act*
  - d) Revenues raised by other means authorized under this or another Act
  - e) Revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise

5. The amount of money that can be requisitioned annually under the *Local Government Act* shall not exceed \$183,000.
6. This bylaw may be cited as the **“Balfour Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2142, 2010”**.

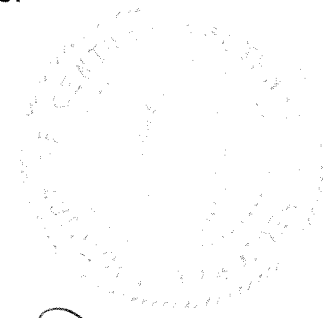

### BYLAW NO. 2288

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2142, being the  
"Balfour Water Service Establishment  
Bylaw No. 2142, 2010"

WHEREAS, a service has been established by the Regional District of Central Kootenay by Bylaw No. 2142, being the "Balfour Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2142, 2010"

AND WHEREAS a request has been received to amend the boundaries of the Balfour Water Service Area to remove the parcel legally described as Lot 1, Plan 16266, DL 7880 AND Lot 2, Plan 16266, DL 7880 from the boundaries of the service area;

AND WHEREAS these properties are licensed to and receive water from Wyandotte Creek;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay deems it expedient to amend Bylaw No. 2142 to modify the service area boundaries as requested;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the *Local Government Act*, the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay has obtained consent on behalf of the participating area in accordance with Section 801.5 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The "Balfour Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2142, 2010", is hereby amended as follows:
  - 1) By modifying the service area boundaries to exclude Lot 1, Plan 16266, DL 7880 AND Lot 2, Plan 16266, DL 7880 as shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw; and,
  - 2) By deleting the Schedule attached to Bylaw No. 2142 and replacing it with the attached Schedule 'A'.
2. This Bylaw may be cited as the "Balfour Water Service Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 2288, 2012."





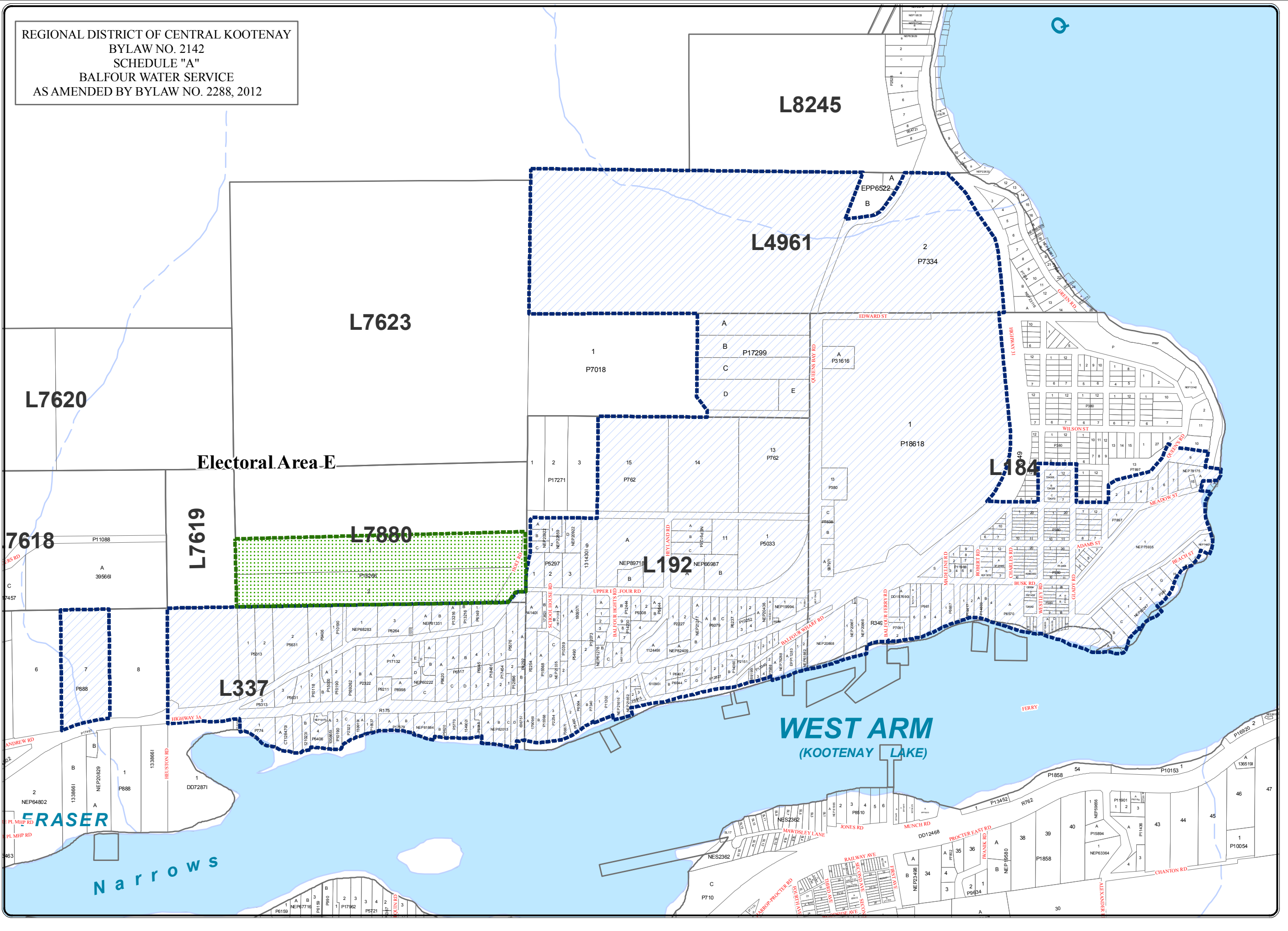

Bylaw No. 2989

A Bylaw to amend Balfour Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2142, 2010 for the purpose of increasing the requisition limit.

WHEREAS the regional district may, by bylaw, establish service under the provisions of the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay established a service for the purpose of operating and maintaining a water system within Balfour by adopting the Balfour Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 2142, 2010;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Regional District Establishment Bylaw Approval Exemption Regulation, a regional district may increase a maximum requisition in service establishment bylaws by 25% or less every five years without inspector approval;

AND WHEREAS consent has been received from the Director of Electoral Area E to increase the requisition limit of said service;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1 Section 5 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
(5) The amount of money that can be requisitioned annually under the Local Government Act shall not exceed \$228,750 (two hundred twenty eight thousand seven hundred fifty dollars).
2 This Bylaw may be cited as "Balfour Water Service Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 2989, 2024."
