BYLAW NO. 805

A Bylaw to establish a local service area within Electoral Area F for the purpose of acquiring, operating and maintaining a water supply system.

WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay may, by bylaw, establish and operate a local service under the provisions of Section 788 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the Board has been requested, by petition under the provisions of Section 801 of the Municipal Act, to establish, operate and maintain a water supply system for the benefit of the residents of the local service area;

AND WHEREAS the sufficiency of the petition has been certified under Section 659 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities is required under Section 795(1)(a) of the Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL KOOTENAY, IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Regional District hereby establishes, within Electoral Area F, a local service for the purpose of providing for the supply, treatment, conveyance, storage and distribution of water within the boundaries of the service area shown outlined on the plan attached, as Schedule "A" to this bylaw and known as "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Area".
2. The maximum amount of money that may be expended for annual operating costs for the service provided under Section 1 shall be Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.00) Dollars.
3. The annual operating and debt servicing costs shall be recovered by requisition of money to be collected by a parcel tax and the imposition of fees and other charges for the purposes of cost recovery.
4. This bylaw may be cited **"Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990"**.



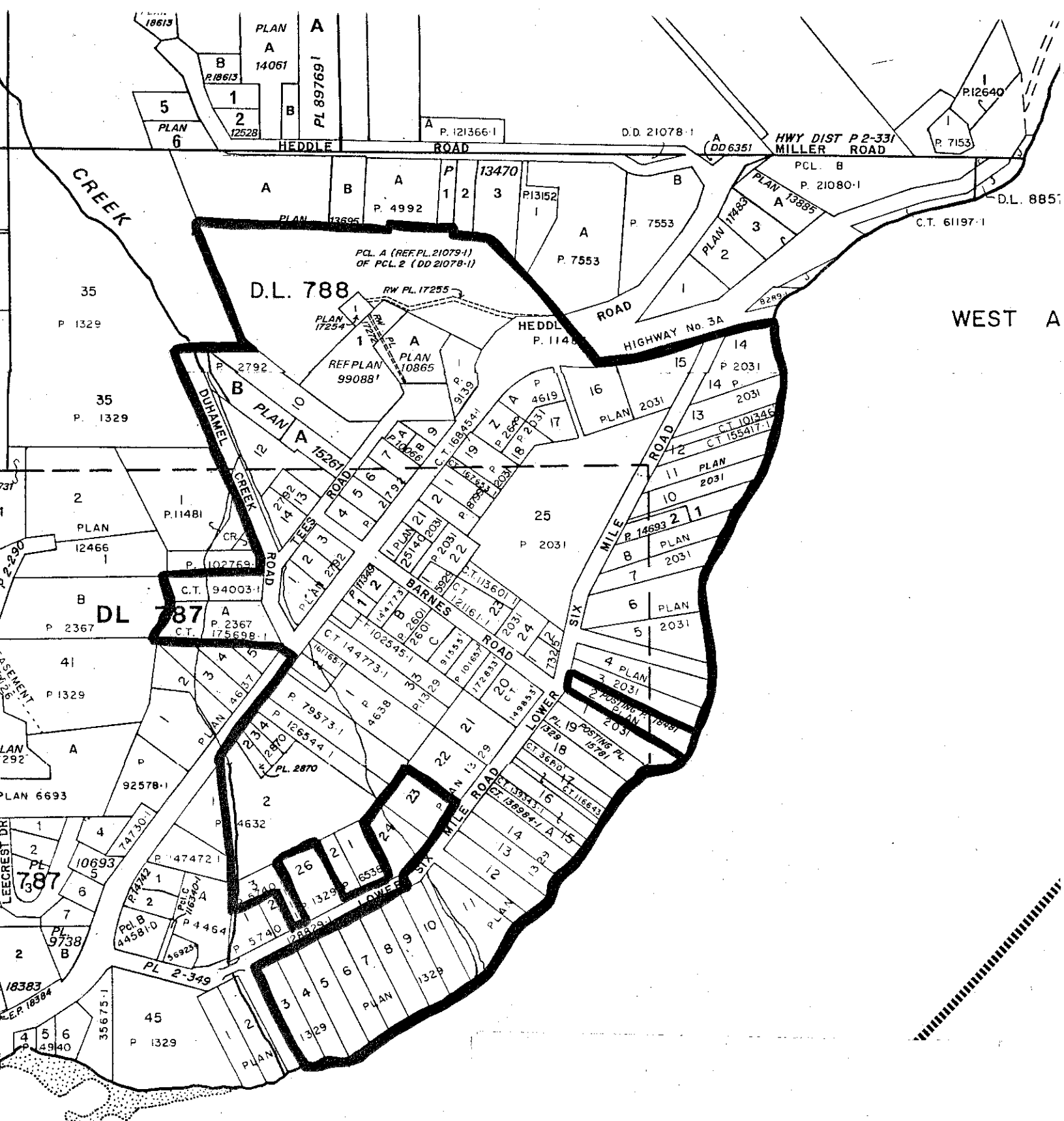

BYLAW NO. 865

A bylaw to amend the Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Area as established by Bylaw No. 805.

WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay in adopting "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990" established a Local Service Area within a portion of Electoral Area F for the purpose of providing for the supply, treatment, conveyance, storage and distribution of water;

AND WHEREAS in establishing the Local Service Area Lot 22, District Lot 787, Kootenay District Plan 1329 was inadvertently included in the Local Service Area;

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL KOOTENAY IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Duhamel Creek Local Area Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990" is hereby amended as follows:
 - a) by deleting from the boundaries of the Local Service Area the land outlined on the plan attached as Schedule 'A' to this bylaw;
 - b) by replacing Schedule 'A' to Bylaw 805 with Schedule 'B' attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw representing the revised "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Area".
2. This bylaw may be cited as the "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Area Establishment Amending Bylaw 865, 1991."



BYLAW NO. 1025

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 805 being a bylaw to establish a local service for the purpose of acquiring, operating and maintaining a water supply service within Electoral Area F known as Duhamel Creek.

WHEREAS under the authority of Bylaw No. 805 cited as "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990" the Regional District established a local service for the purpose of operating and maintaining a water supply system;

AND WHEREAS the annual cost attributable to the operation of the water system exceeds the expenditure limit of Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000.) Dollars;

NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL KOOTENAY IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990" be amended as follows:
 - a) Clause 2 be deleted in its entirety and the following be substituted therefor:
 2. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually under Section 804(1) of the Municipal Act for the service shall be \$30,000.

2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Amendment Bylaw No. 1025, 1993."

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay has obtained consent on behalf of the participating area director in accordance with Section 801.5 of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:


1. The "Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990." is hereby amended as follows:
 - (1) By modifying the service area boundaries to exclude Lot B Plan NEP22683 District Lot 788 Kootenay Land District Except Plan NEP62998 as shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw; and,
 - (2) By deleting the Schedule attached to Bylaw 805 and replacing it with the attached Schedule 'A'.
2. This Bylaw may be cited as the **"Duhamel Creek Water Local Service Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 2461, 2015."**

Bylaw No. 2991

A Bylaw to amend Duhamel Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990 for the purpose of increasing the requisition limit.

WHEREAS the regional district may, by bylaw, establish service under the provisions of the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay established a service for the purpose of operating and maintaining a water system within Duhamel by adopting the Duhamel Water Service Establishment Bylaw No. 805, 1990;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Regional District Establishment Bylaw Approval Exemption Regulation, a regional district may increase a maximum requisition in service establishment bylaws by 25% or less every five years without inspector approval;

AND WHEREAS consent has been received from the Director of Electoral Area F to increase the requisition limit of said service;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Central Kootenay, in open meeting assembled, HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1 Section 2 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
(2) The amount of money that can be requisitioned annually under the Local Government Act shall not exceed \$37,500 (thirty seven thousand five hundred dollars).
2 This Bylaw may be cited as "Duhamel Water Service Establishment Amendment Bylaw No. 2991, 2024."
