

DEFINITIONS

“AGREEMENT” “CONTRACT” means the written agreement resulting from this Negotiated Request for Proposals executed by the RDCK and the Contractor.

“RDCK” means the Regional District of Central Kootenay.

“CONTRACTOR” means the person(s) firm(s) or corporation(s) appointed by the RDCK to carry out all duties, obligations, work and services described in the Negotiated Request for Proposals and all associated documentation, which may also include mutually agreed revisions subsequent to submission of a Proposal. Both “Contractor” and “Proponent” are complementary in terms of duties, obligations and responsibilities contemplated at the Negotiated Request for Proposals stage, through evaluation process, execution and performance of the Services.

“MAXIMUM CONTRACT PRICE” means the maximum amount that will be paid by the RDCK to the Contractor for delivery and acceptance of goods and Services.

“RDCK REPRESENTATIVE” means the RDCK staff member appointed to coordinate the Services, which is identified in the NRFP Key Information section.

“PROPONENT” means responder to this Negotiated Request for Proposals.

“PROPOSAL” means the submission by the Proponent.

“NEGOTIATED REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS” “NRFP” shall mean and include the complete set of documents, specifications and addenda incorporated herein, and included in this Negotiated Request for Proposals.

“SERVICES” “WORK” “WORKS” means and includes the provision by the successful Proponent of all services, duties, and expectations as further described in this NRFP. This will also mean the whole of the work, tools, materials, labour, equipment, travel, and all that is required to be done, furnished and performed by the Contractor.

“SHALL” “MUST” “WILL” “MANDATORY” means a requirement that must be met.

“SUPPLY” “PROVIDE” shall mean supply and pay for and provide and pay for.
