

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT WITH 2026 REDI GRANTS?

HOW CAN I CHECK IF MY APPLICATION WAS RECEIVED?

Thank you to the many organization for your interest in the 2026 Resident Directed (ReDi) Grants Program. The deadline for submitting 2026 proposals was on February 20th, 2026. After submitting your proposal, you should have received a confirmation email along with a copy of the submission. After submissions are received, they undergo a thorough review to determine whether they meet the eligibility requirements. If the submission is deemed eligible, organizations will be notified via email.

WHEN WILL THE SUBMISSION REVIEW BE COMPLETED?

It is expected that the review process will be completed by, Monday March 23rd, 2026. We will post a list of proposals that satisfy the qualification criteria at rdck.ca/ReDi.

WHEN & WHERE ARE THE RESIDENT INPUT MEETINGS?

Resident input meetings are scheduled to be held in different parts of the RDCK throughout the month of April. For more information on meeting dates, times, and locations, please visit rdck.ca/ReDi on Friday, March 13, 2026.

DO ORGANIZATIONS NEED TO ATTEND THE RESIDENT INPUT MEETINGS?

ReDi Grants are intended to be flexible and incorporate community-based funding decisions.

ReDi Grants delivery within the RDCK involves more than 20 distinct community-based public processes. Organizations may be required to attend a public meeting in a particular area that they are requesting funding support from.

Organizations are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the various processes and formats of meetings as they can differ. Please visit rdck.ca/ReDi on March 13th, 2026 for the 2026 ReDi resident input meeting details and if you are obligated to attend the meeting.

To ensure that your group is ready for the meeting, it is important to be prepared to present your proposals and answer any questions from the committee or the public. All supporting documents submitted with the online application should be brought by the organizations to the resident input meetings.

WHEN WILL PROPOSALS FOR SUPPORT BE APPROVED?

Recommendations from each area's adjudication committee of the Resident Input Meetings will be presented for approval during the May 21st, 2026 RDCK Board Meeting.

WHAT IS THE TIMEFRAME FOR THE 2026 REDI GRANTS PERIOD?

The 2026 ReDi Grants project period is defined as May 22nd, 2026 to June 30th, 2027. All 2026 projects are expected to be completed during this time.

WHEN WILL I RECEIVE 2026 REDI GRANTS PAYMENT?

Funding payments for approved proposals will be disbursed in June and July. To receive funding support of \$5,000.00 or more, organization must sign a funding agreement prior to the release of funding. Organizations with the required agreement will be contacted by the grants coordinator.

WHAT ARE THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS?

- Ensure projects are completed by June 30, 2027.
- Make sure that all the funds allocated for the project have been utilized according to the approved proposals.
- Voluntarily and without reminders, submit a Final Financial Report upon completion of their project or no later than December 31, 2027.
- Visit rdck.ca/ReDi for the most up-to-date reporting links and guidelines.
- Ensure to include copies of all receipts, invoices, and other supporting documentation that demonstrate how the total amount of grant funding was utilized when submitting the final financial report.
- Grant recipients are required to return any unused funds to the RDCK before the final financial report will be approved. Please do not return the funds until you have checked with the grants coordinator.

WHAT ABOUT EXTENSIONS OR CHANGE OF SCOPE REQUESTES?

Should projects not be completed by June 30th, 2027, it is advised to obtain an authorized extension or authorized change of scope before October 31, 2027.

Submit a ReDi grants extension or change of scope request at rdck.ca/ReDi.

Organizations must submit complete and outstanding project financial reports by December 31st, 2027 to be eligible for grant funding consideration in the future. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility until the report is submitted and approved.
