## RECREATION INSTRUCTOR & PROGRAM MONITOR — SKATEPARK INSTRUCTOR & HOST

Under the general direction of the Recreation Services Supervisor and Head Recreation & Fitness Leader, the **Recreation Instructor & Recreation Monitor – Skatepark Instructor & Host** is responsible for creating a safe and fun environment for youth and adults at the Creston & District Community Complex Skatepark. The employee supervises and instructs participants in skatepark activities and programs while ensuring patrons understand and follow all rules and safety guidelines. The successful candidate will foster a welcoming, inclusive and non-competitive environment for all users.

Responsibilities include assisting with program planning and delivery, supervising participants, ensuring equipment and activity areas are safe and ready for use, providing instruction and guidance in skatepark programs, monitoring participant behaviour, and communicating any safety concerns or incidents to supervisors. The position also supports daily program operations including equipment setup and takedown, attendance tracking, and general patron support.

### REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Demonstrated experience with skateboarding or similar skatepark activities
- Knowledge and skills building relationships with patrons and managing behaviour with youth and adults
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
- Excellent customer service and public relations skills
- Independent decision-making, problem solving and analytical skills
- Strong leadership skills
- Ability to work well within a team
- A high level of creativity and flexibility
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs and assist with equipment setup and takedown

This is a term part-time position from June to August. The normal hourly rates are the following based on experience:

Recreation Program Monitor— \$18.25-\$20.02

Scheduled shifts may include days, evenings and weekends.
