LAKESIDE SUMMER CAMP LIFEGUARD

Part-Time—Term
July—August 2026

Under direction from the Head Lifeguard, the Summer Camp Lifeguard is responsible for the safety of summer camp participants at Lakeside Park at all times during swimming & other water activities at the lake, as well as assisting other Program staff with the set up and take down of various water activities.

The Summer Camp Lifeguard must be able to perform rescues and first aid as required.

The successful candidates must follow the established departmental (Community Recreation) and Lakeside Park guidelines for operating standards.

This position will be required to work approximately 2 hours per day, 5 days a week during July and August while summer camp is in effect.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard Award – Pool Option (NL)
- Standard First Aid current within 2 years
- Current CPR C certified annually
- Satisfactory Criminal Record
- Other appropriate aquatic awards would be considered an asset

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Exceptional customer service focus.
- Able to work with patrons of varying age groups.
- Strong verbal communication skills; including excellent customer service and public relation skills.
- Ability to work well in a team.
- Able to lift up to 50 lbs.
- Perform physical skill requirements for NLS.

The current rate of pay for Summer Camp Lifeguards is \$24.89 per hour as per the Lifeguard rate outlined in the Collective Agreement.

These are based on program requirements while Summer Camps run in July and August 2026. The Lakeside Lifeguard will work within their Bronze Cross Scope of practice.

Applicants should be available to work a varied work schedule that includes day, weekend and/or evening shifts.
