### AUXILIARY-As and When Needed

The Resource Recovery Site Operator, under the direction of the Resource Recovery Operations Supervisor, or designate, is responsible for safe and efficient operations of the Grohman Narrows Transfer Station, and other RDCK Resource Recovery Facilities.

The Grohman Narrows Transfer Station Operator is required to operate machinery and perform general maintenance where required. This position requires occasional travel to RDCK facilities.

#### REQUIRED TRAINING & CERTIFICATIONS:

- Maintain valid BC Class 5 Driver's license;
- General knowledge of small equipment operation and maintenance;
- Ability to work independently;
- Ability to deal courteously and effectively with the public;
- Ability to deal effectively with other staff;
- Ability to operate a front end loader and other equipment in a competent and safe manner;
- Ability to prioritize work tasks;
- Ability to lift 18 kilograms and carry for 5 meters;
- Ability to work outside in adverse weather conditions; and
- Ability to remain standing for up to 3 hours at one time.

#### PREFERRED TRAINING & CERTIFICATIONS:

- Completion of Grade 12 or recognized equivalent;
- Maintain valid BC Class 3 or Class 1 Driver's License; and
- General knowledge of landfill and waste transfer station operations;
- Endorsement 15 Vehicles with Air Brakes.
