Off-Road Vehicle Prohibition Rescinded on Nelson Salmo Great Northern Trail and at Glacier Creek Regional Park

Nelson, BC: The off-road vehicle prohibition on the Nelson Salmo Great Northern Trail and at Glacier Creek Regional Park has been rescinded, effective immediately.

The Regional District of Central Kootenay (RDCK) is following the Province's lead, as these parks fall within the Southeast Fire Centre. The Province rescinded its recreational off-road vehicle prohibition on Crown land in the Southeast Fire Centre effective noon on Friday, August 28.

Residents and visitors are reminded that off-road vehicle use is already prohibited or restricted in many RDCK regional parks and trails, including on a portion of the Nelson Salmo Great Northern Trail. Please continue to follow all park regulations and wildfire-related restrictions when using RDCK parks and trails.
