FACILITY MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN

INTERNAL

Under the general supervision of the Operations Supervisor, the Facility Maintenance Technician is a skilled, trained and adaptable tradesperson responsible for the preventative maintenance and upkeep of the mechanical operations of our multi-use facilities. The Technician provides effective leadership for the preventative maintenance and operations of the facilities under the jurisdiction of the Castlegar & District Recreation Department (CDRD).

This role requires considerable knowledge of best practices and operations of Recreation Facility Operations and will work to ensure the facility maintenance program is carried out according to policies, standards and regulations in order to optimize operational effectiveness, efficiency and safety.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES:

- Strong mechanical aptitude with the ability to troubleshoot, diagnose issues, develop solutions, and perform routine maintenance and repairs on equipment, buildings, and related systems.
- General knowledge of electrical, HVAC, plumbing, heating, hot water, ventilation, Building Management Systems (DDC controls), arena refrigeration/ice plants, and pool filtration systems, including UV and chlorine systems.
- Ability to operate, monitor, and interpret meters, gauges, and equipment; perform calculations and tests; and maintain accurate reports, logs, and records.
- Knowledge of WHMIS and the safe handling, use, storage, and transportation of hazardous chemicals and dangerous goods.
- Strong organizational, administrative, communication, and interpersonal skills, with the ability to work independently, exercise sound judgment, manage competing operational needs, and work effectively as part of a team.
- Demonstrated leadership, supervisory, mentoring, and coaching skills, with the ability to communicate courteously and effectively with coworkers, supervisors, and the public. Proficiency with Microsoft Office, including Word and Excel, and willingness to continue learning.

PREFERRED TRAINING & CERTIFICATIONS:

- Transportation of Dangerous Goods Certification (TDG)
- Class 4 Refrigeration Power Engineering Certification

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

- Red Seal (or equivalent) Journeyperson's ticket in applicable trade with preference given to Industrial Mechanic (Millwright), Plumber or HVAC and Refrigeration Mechanic. Additional trades would be considered with an acceptable equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Experience or knowledge relating to the mechanical workings of large scale facilities.
- Valid B.C. Drivers License
- Standard First Aid and CPR
- Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) 2015 Certification.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record

REQUIRED TRAINING & CERTIFICATIONS:

- Refrigeration Operator Certificate of Qualification
- Pool Operation Level 2 Certificate of Competency or equivalent
